Thomas Fletcher the Brother of the deceased and
sole Executor named in the said Will to whom administration
was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and
Credits of the said deceased having been first sworn by a
Commission duly to administer.

Daughter Hannah Russell the sum of fifty Pounds
these Payments to commence within six Months
after my decease all my Debts owing by me William
Faden together with all Interest thereon to be well re-
paid on his complying with the above Conditions &
wherein are to pay to his Sisters Judith & Jane Faden
the sum of two hundred and fifty Pounds to each
of them and to his Sister Hannah Russell the sum of
fifty Pounds I leave my Wife Hannah & my Son
William Faden Executor and Executor to this my
last Will dated this present day the twenty fourth
of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and eighty one, W. Faden. Witness

eighty one and in the twenty first year of the Reign
of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace
of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King
Defender of the Faith and so forth, Mich^e Fowler
