Boy To my daughter Etheldreda my picture called The Cottager's Return and  
To my son Hubert Russell my four small crayons I give devise and bequeath  
all the rest residue and remainder of my real and personal estate of whatsoever  
kind and wheresoever situate of which I may die possessed unto and to the use  
of my wife Anne Maria her heirs executors administrators and assigns absolutely  
Subject nevertheless to the payment thereof of my just debts funeral and testa-  
mentary expenses And I give to her her heirs executors and administrators  
all estates vested in me as a trustee or mortgagee upon the trusts and equities  
affecting the same respectively And I appoint my said wife sole Executrix  
of this my Will In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand the day  
and year above written — John Cross — Signed by the said John  
Cross the testator as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us

who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other subscribe

On the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January 1885 Probate of this Will was granted to  
Anne Maria Cross widow the sole Executrix.
